

# 12th Asia-Pacific Rally

## General Information

- Organizer :** Japan Auto Camping Federation
- Dates:** Friday, November 20 to Monday, November 23, 2009
- Venue:** Green Villa Daigo
- Fees:** Adults: 6000yen/person  
Children (ages6 -12):4000 yen/person
- Application:** Applications for participation must be submitted between 1 May and 31 July 2009.

### Accommodation facilities:

- 6 Family Cabins: 33,600 yen/cabin  
9 Group Cabins:50,400 yen/cabin  
43 individual tent sites: 10,500 yen/site

- \* A Family Cabin is for 4 guests and can accommodate 5 guests at maximum.
- \* A Group Cabin is for 8 guests and can accommodate 12 guests at maximum.
- \* An individual tent site can be used by up to 5 campers.
- \* Each Cabin is equipped with a toilet, shower, kitchen, refrigerator, table, chairs, and tableware for the number of guests.
- \* A set of camping tools (tent, sleeping bag, cookware) is rented for10,500 yen.
- \* The above fees will cover the entire Rally period.

## Excursion

Fukuroda Falls -- Okukuji Cha-no-Sato Park -- Oyaki School

Fee: 3,000 yen/person (including fees for entrance of each facility, tea and snacks served at the tea house, *oyaki* tasting at Oyaki School, and lunch)

The participants will view Fukuroda Falls, one of Japan's three most powerful waterfalls, in close proximity at the view point. At Okukuji Cha-no-Sato Park, the famous local tea will be served at the tea house. Finally, they will taste the local product *oyaki* at Oyaki School.

*Oyaki*: A Japanese dumpling made from a fermented buckwheat dough wrapped around a stuffing of Japanese vegetables, fruit, or anko bean paste and then roasted on an iron pan. (Source: <http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Oyaki>)
